

We have expanded our offerings and brought in remarkable professional instructors, each of whom brings an extensive résumé of experience in teaching and theatre. OCPA is very privileged to have them with us.

We are also happy to announce that we have recently received grants from the Bravo Channel and the Anna May and Cow Creek Foundations to help the children of low-income families attend our camps and classes. We are always looking for funding through grants, donations, and other avenues so we can continue building a complete year-around performing arts school for youth in the Rogue Valley. The Oregon Conservatory continues to grow. Now in our seventh year, we are offering more-distinctive after-school and Saturday classes in the performing arts. This fall we will be offering new classes in directing, scene study, audition techniques, Shakespeare, and more. We'll also reprise our most popular offerings: Kids on Stage, Playtime Acting, Young Singers, and Rock Band 101 and 102. 'Grown' is a special project this fall—an exceptional opportunity for teens to update an original coming-of-age script with their own words and experiences and then perform the musical on local stages.






