as part of Daedalus Project



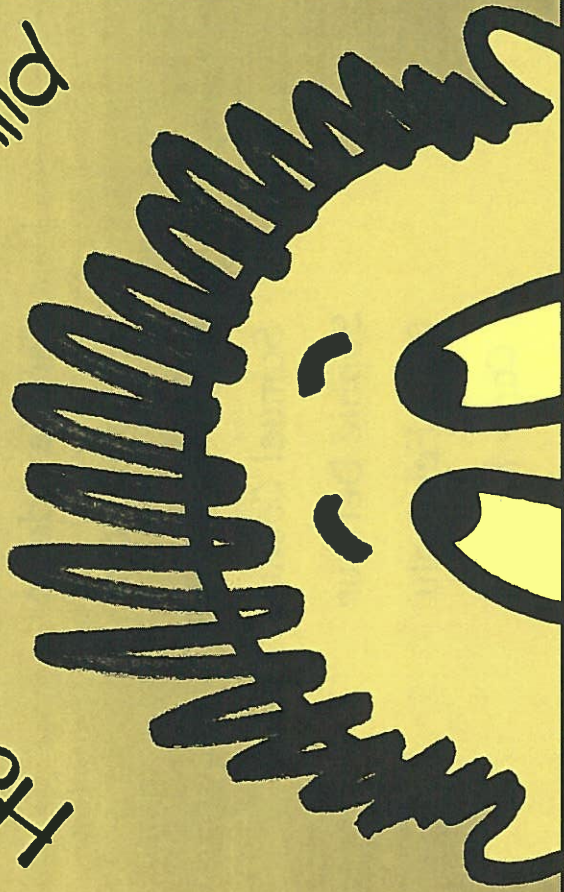

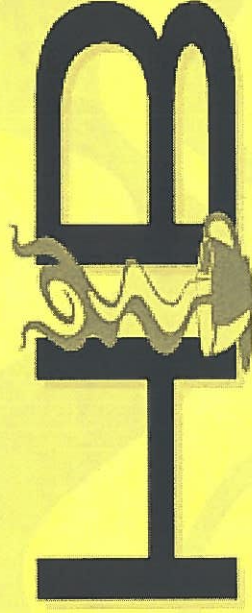
### Our Mission

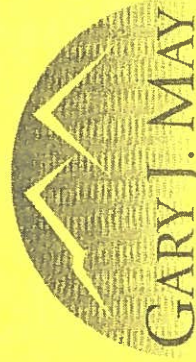

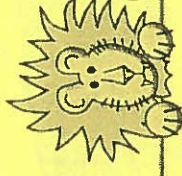
I cannot tell you what growth and change I have seen in these young people over the past three weeks. Those who are closest to them won't need to be told—you'll just see it.
