

## Director's Notes

Many women deal with the pressures of employment in a fast paced corporate environment, sacrificing their identity and integrity just to "make it". Our heroine in Legally Blonde, Elle Woods, portrays just such a woman. But she is smart and adept at using her realm of knowledge in the legal arena. She takes a great stand against the stereotypical concept of a "blonde". She withstands the advances of a lecherous professor, overcomes prejudice, and throughout the story is driven by her heart. How can we not love her? How can we not learn from her? And all along the way she makes us laugh.

At first glimpse, the idea of making Elle a roll model for our cast seemed superficial and limiting. But as we got to know her, it became clear that she is more than just her hair and clothing. Inside, her principals, generosity and ability to lift those around her, including her enemies, are ideals that we would all want our daughters (and sons) to emanate. In the words of the song, "I'm standing here today because you helped me find my way," illustrates the completion of a journey and her meek acknowledgment that she could not have arrived without the support of many. This too is what we want for our children. Not just to "arrive", but to learn all along the journey from those with whom they come into contact.

In these five weeks as directors, we hope the cast has learned from Elle's journey, from each other, the staff, and what it takes to make something big happen: the four C's -- Communication, Cooperation, Commitment and Collaboration. Elle used them all and look where it got her! We would like to thank Jeff for the opportunity to work together as a directorial team, the cast and staff for their dedication and the families for providing this camp opportunity for your teen. We did it all for love "cause we love you guys. OMG!"


